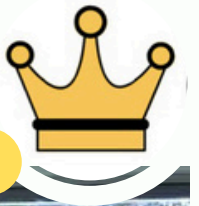

The Rare Reminder's Article about Noble Care, LLC: New Adult Day Care Center Provides Needed Services To Many

ROCKY HILL - An adult day care center that assists seniors with cognitive or physical declines has opened in Rocky Hill.

Owner of Noble Care, Elaina Noble, said the center opened last October. "We offer seniors an opportunity to socialize and enjoy activities while being supervised in a safe environment," Noble said.

Located at 15 Elm St., the center is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

According to Noble, seniors are entertained by different games and exercise routines. "Our senior clients often enjoy games of Bingo, Family Feud, Boggle, and numerous other games that are cognitively stimulating," she said. "The clients also enjoy daily exercise routines that include light calisthenics, chair yoga, walking, and stretching."

Noble said the center offers arts and crafts, including painting, scrapbooking, and seasonal decor. She also said there is a sensory therapy room

to promote physical sense stimulation. "Clients can engage in activities that stimulate them visually, tactically, or auditorily," she said. "I think the most important thing that seniors get to do at our center is socialize with each other and the staff."

According to Noble, the center was created to provide socialization for seniors. "Typically, when a new client starts at Noble Care, they are introverted and closed off because they have not been engaged in the months prior," she said. "We get to watch them open up and bring out their beautiful personalities."

Noble described socialization as amazing and rewarding and said family members and spouses had seen a positive change in the center's clients. "Although we've only been open for about nine months, we've witnessed this over and over again," she said.

According to Noble, the Rocky Hill community needed an adult daycare service after another closed location. "After the closing of the

prior center, seniors were forced to travel long distances to get to other adult day care centers or were left home and didn't have the opportunity to socialize with others," she said.

Noble said the center is geared towards seniors in need of support. "Seniors get to experience the benefits of the center, but families are also relieved of their caretaking duties for a short while," she said. "The seniors also get to experience a high quality of life, and their family members get to experience their loved ones' happy dispositions."

According to Noble, seniors could become

more extroverted at the center. She also described the center as a positive and uplifting community. "Adults are able to come out of their shells and communicate with others, all while discovering bits and pieces of themselves they may have forgotten," she said. "Being able to see the effect of the happy atmosphere at Noble Care is incredibly heartwarming."
